What character traits do you currently possess that you feel would be an asset to the overall governance of the East Coast Credit Union Board of Directors?

I am thoughtful, patient and persistent in following goals.

I was raised and educated in England. Obtained CA in 1969. Immigrated to Canada in 1974. Obtained Nova Scotia CA designation in 1975. In October 1976 I started a Public Accounting practice, which has been my full-time occupation ever since, providing a full range of services to family businesses. Over the years I have served on the Nova Scotia CA Institute's Professional Development, Practitioners', Taxation, Professional Conduct and Planning & Priorities Committees, as well as with CICA's Impact CA Group, bringing matters of concern to the profession to the attention of Federal Government representatives.

From 1987 through 2000, I was active in the local soccer community. At different times I served as scheduler, treasurer, director, referee, team coach and team manager. In 1993 I was a founding member of the Beaver Bank (N.S.) Community Awareness Association, and I continue a close relationship with this organization. I have been involved with ISANS on an advisory board and delivering seminars to recent immigrants to Nova Scotia.

What skills, knowledge, and experiences do you bring that you believe will contribute to our Board of Directors, i.e. community involvement, board experiences etc.?

I am a CPA with more than forty years of operating my own public accounting practice. I served for twelve years on the board of governors of the Northwood Group of Companies, four of which I Chaired the Board. In addition I served for three years on the Board of Directors of the Northwood Foundation. I have served as Treasurer and President of the Sackville NS Lions Club. Since 2016, I have been a Board member and Treasurer of the Beacon House Interfaith Society, operating a thrift store and food bank in Sackville, N.S.
