In those roles, I have been involved in strategy development, governance implementation, amalgamation discussions, performance evaluation, etc.
- Outside of the credit union system, I have governance expertise nationally, regionally and in community. I currently am a director of the Physician Assessment Centre of Excellence (PACE) and the Medical Council of Canada. In my community, I am Treasurer of both the Antigonish Affordable Housing Society and the Creative Wellness Society (which operates the Adult Friendship Corner) and am the public member on the Audit Committee of the Town of Antigonish. I continue to develop an understanding of the resiliency of community and how community supports its members.
